Dear Friends,

Catholic tradition calls this Fourth Sunday of Easter "Good Shepherd Sunday." In the Gospel of John, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd and his followers as the sheep of his flock. He also proclaims his loving care even for those who do not yet belong to his fold. The Church also designates this weekend as World Day of Prayer for Vocations, asking Jesus our Good Shepherd to call generous souls to serve the Lord's flock in the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life. The challenge today, as every day, is to listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd and to follow him unreservedly wherever he leads, ultimately to the Kingdom of Heaven!

It seems somewhat fitting that on Good Shepherd Sunday and Vocation Sunday that we recognize in a special way REVEREND MR. THOMAS SCHULTES, our transitional deacon from the Diocese of Lincoln, for his ministry among us first as a seminarian and now as a deacon. Father Tralies and I will miss Deacon Tom. Deacon Tom concludes his ministry here today and will return shortly to his diocese where he will be ordained a priest on May 26, 2012. Next weekend we will celebrate First Holy Communion with the third grade students of our parish. Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, May 5th at 10:30 AM and some of our young members will receive their First Holy Communion on Sunday, May 6th at the 11:00 AM Mass. As we all remember, this is a special day for our young people and our parish. Let us pray for these parishioners as they ready themselves to receive Jesus in Holy Communion for the first time. 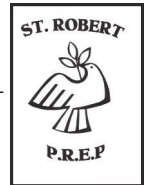

Family Connection to the Gospel...

Jesus is the model Good Shepherd. He cares for his sheep; they know his voice and respond. There is ownership. Jesus knows his sheep and knows them by name. He is in a loving relationship with them which is why he is willing to lay down his life for them. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, protects the sheep with his life.

The Good Shepherd makes sacrifices for his sheep not because it is required, but because it is a choice made in a loving relationship. *That sounds a lot like parenting and the dynamics of a healthy family life.* Parents choose to make sacrifices for their children out of love, not obligation. Christian parents model and invite their children to choose to make sacrifices for other family members and for other people, acting out of love rather than obligation. When you gather as a family, invite each family member to consider the attitude that permeates their participation in family life.

*Do we do family chores cheerfully and without having to be asked multiple times?
Do we gladly share with others? Do we willingly contribute to the family good when asked?*

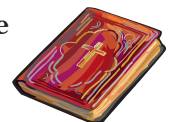
