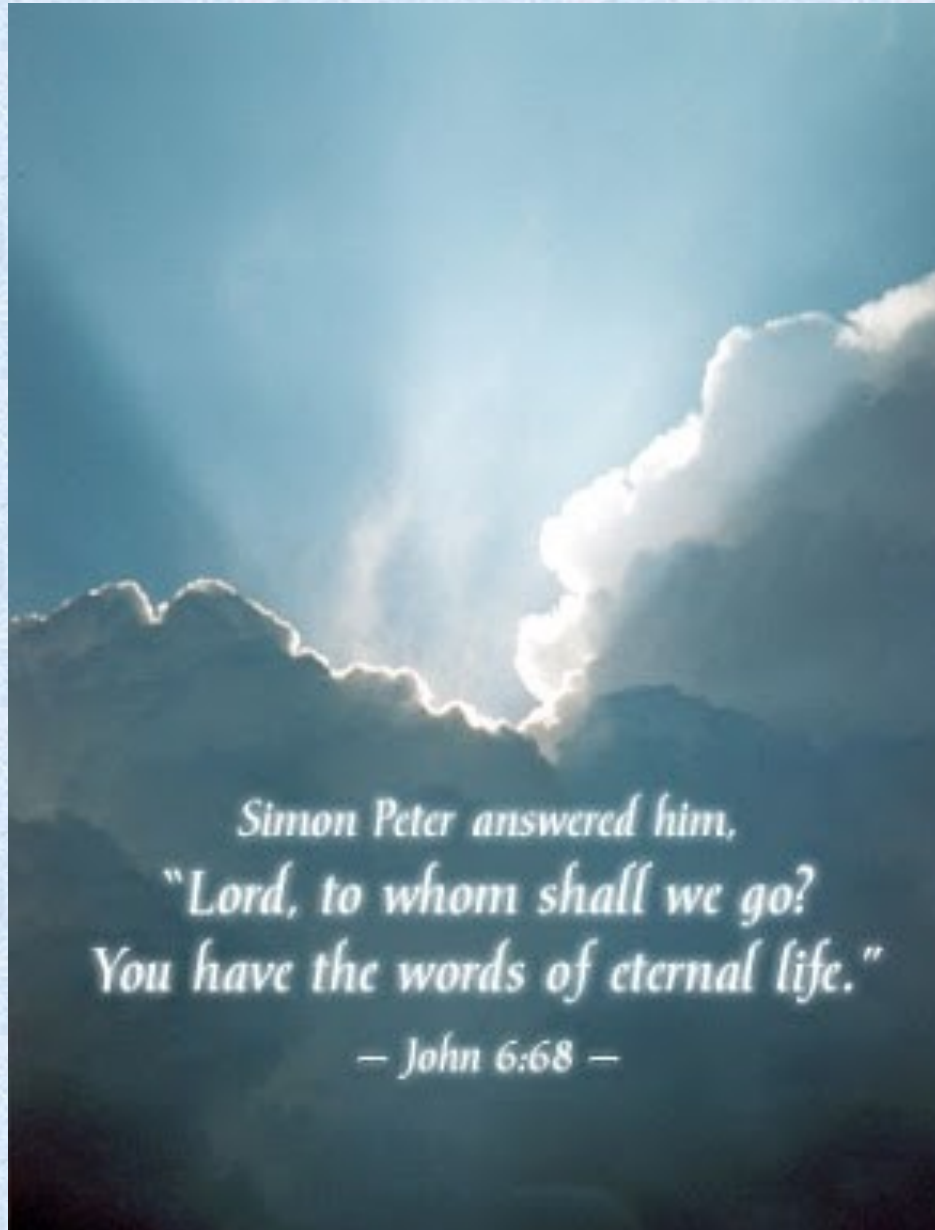

SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM

On December 31, 2014, 23 pieces of Pennsylvania State legislation were enacted that impact the way we prevent and report child abuse. As a result, all people who volunteer for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia are required fulfill the following obligations:

- ◆ PA Department of Public Welfare Child Abuse Clearance Check
- ◆ Federal History Fingerprint Clearance ~ ONLY if you lived outside of PA within the last 10 years

Happy August! A few gentle reminders for the upcoming weeks:

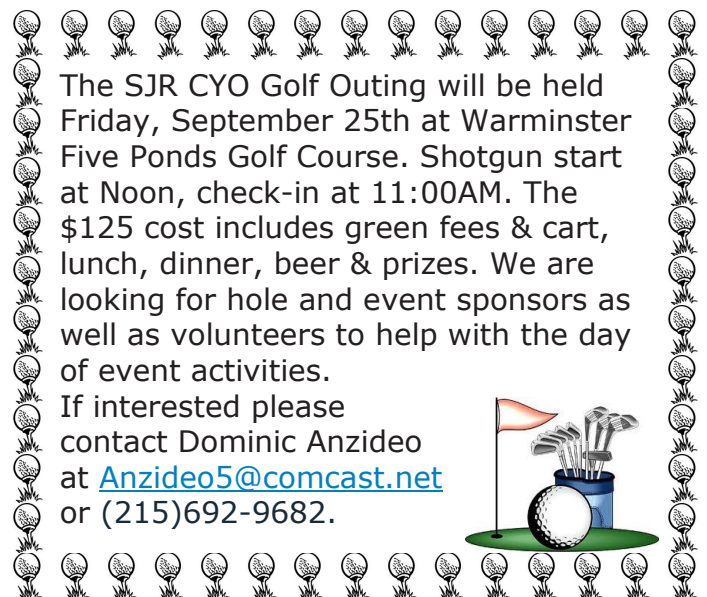

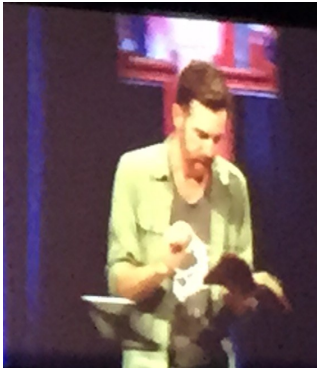
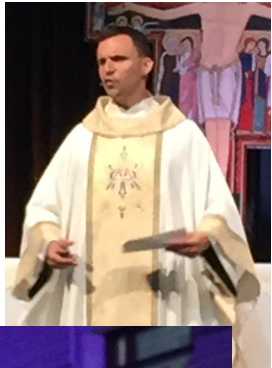

FOCUS ON FAITH

TWENTYFIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflection on Prayer —Toward Union - Prayer of Recollection

Lessons from Saint Teresa of Avila (from *Beginning Contemplative Prayer* by Kathryn J. Hermes, FSP)

Saint Teresa wants us to know that Jesus is within. We don't need to shout, to call him on our cell phone, or wildly wave our hands to get his attention. A whisper is all that is needed; a remembrance of him in our heart. Teresa's teaching on prayer is simple. She sees three steps as essential for mental prayer: to search for God, to be alone with him, and to look on him present within us. In order for us to truly pray, God must have a name, a face, an attraction. As we long to get together with old friends, we should long to be alone with God, to converse with him out of a deep mutual knowledge and love. The search for God springs from love.

Jesus advised his first disciples to retreat into their room, close the door, and pray to God in secret. Teresa takes him at his word. Our love for Jesus will deepen, she says, the more we have the habit of being in his presence, listening to him, savoring his words. She teaches that love leads us to create a rhythm of inner prayer, of returning to the depths of our heart where we can be alone with Jesus and simply love him. But how do we do this?

Saint Teresa's answer is in her third principle of prayer: simply look upon God present in your soul. It may help to form a picture of Jesus and then to look at him, or to picture a scene from the Gospel that attracts your heart. At other times, a strong sense of Jesus' presence draws our gaze inward. Teresa's guidance on prayer does not involve meditations and reflections . . . only lovingly keeping company with Jesus. Her whole spiritual doctrine can be boiled down to this: simply look at the Lord present in your soul and treat him as a friend.

So let us begin.

1. *Find a quiet space.* Establish a sacred place where you can meet Christ.
2. *Collect your senses and turn them inward.* Begin to look inward, listen within, taste the spirit, thirst for the divine. . . . In other words, collect your faculties and enter within yourself to be with your God. Your eyes will gently close on their own as you withdraw your senses from exterior things and begin to awake to things of the soul.
3. *Place yourself in the presence of Christ.* Picture the Lord. Reach out to touch his hand or his cloak. Feel his gaze locking with your own, or have a general impression of his nearness. Listen for his voice. In whatever way is more helpful for you, grow accustomed to being inflamed with love for him. (Saint Teresa always had a book with her when she prayed. At the beginning of her prayer she would read a bit to collect her thoughts, and she often returned to its pages, or even to a simple holy card, to renew her intensity as she prayed.)
4. *Speak with the Lord as with a friend.* Intimacy grows through conversation and time spent together. Ask the Lord for what you need. Complain. Share excitement. Express sorrow. Offer praise. Seek to truly grow in love for the Lord to whom we owe so much.
