## CELEBRATE HER CANONIZATION

*September 4, 2016*



### Mother Teresa, Model of Mercy

Mother Teresa's life is a model of God's unconditional love and mercy for everyone. She urged us to respond with mercy in our own journeys, especially in the 'smaller things.' **Fr. Brian Kolodiejchuk** is the postulator (the person who guides a **cause for beatification** or **canonization** through the judicial processes required by the Roman Catholic Church) for the cause of canonization for Mother Teresa provides us with some poignant but simple insights.

- Mother Teresa practiced faithfully the corporal and spiritual works of mercy but realized that spiritual poverty is much more of a challenge. To be "unwanted, uncared, forgotten, lonely — this is much greater poverty." "...to remove that loneliness, to remove that terrible hurt, needs prayer, needs sacrifice, needs tenderness and love." These things are often more difficult to give than material things.
- Her method to practice the works of mercy was a method of "humble works." She was not concerned with doing "big things," but she asked that we "Do small things with great love" and "ordinary things with extraordinary love."
- In her words, "Just think a moment, you and I have been called by our name, because he loved us. Because you and I are special to him—to be his heart to love him in the poor, his hands to serve him in the poorest of the poor...beginning with those around us, and even in our **families.**"

*For Reflection:* Mother Teresa teaches us that "thoughtfulness is the beginning of great sanctity." Sometimes being thoughtful is as simple as smiling at your spouse, your children, or your neighbor, or being cheerful even when things are tough and you feel a bit "off." Smile anyway! You never know what effect it may have on others—and you!

*One time while attending a meeting, Mother Teresa was asked to give a little inspirational message. She stood up and looked out at the group and simply said that husbands should smile at their wives and wives should smile at their husbands and children. Someone wondered how she could give this advice and asked her, "Are you married?" She replied that she certainly was married—to Jesus—and sometimes she found it difficult to smile at Jesus because he could be so demanding!*

- are not baptized
- are baptized in another Christian tradition
