Of Advent

Dear Friends,

As we begin the Second Week of Advent, we hear that familiar call of John the Baptist, "prepare the way of the Lord." This is a call not only for this particular season of grace but a daily call for the Christian. The spirit of joyful hope, which Advent calls us to, is the daily disposition by which we can live in peace in the world with those around us. Keeping constantly focused on the effects of grace, begun in the Incarnation, gives us the personal resources to weather the challenges of life, both good and bad. Prepare the way of the Lord this week in prayer and silence and let these words echo in our daily living!

This Tuesday is December 8th, the Holyday of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We are all obligated to celebrate Mass that day to honor the patroness of the United States. Masses will be celebrated here at Saint Robert's at 7AM, 9AM, 12 Noon and 7PM.

Also on December 8th, the Church will begin the **Year of Mercy**. On April 11, 2015, Pope Francis announced "an extraordinary jubilee, a Holy Year of Mercy that is to have God's mercy at its center." The Holy Father wants us to live this Holy Year in the light of Jesus' word: "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). In light of this, the motto of this Holy Year is *Merciful like the Father is Merciful*. Our task is to contemplate, imitate, and adopt God's mercy as our lifestyle. Throughout the year there will be many opportunities to reflect upon this mercy and how it is in mercy that we intimately touch the Heart of Jesus. In light of this Holy Year, please make it a priority this Advent to experience this mercy through the Sacrament of Penance offered throughout the season. 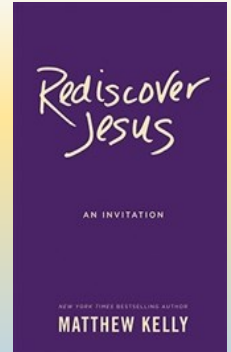

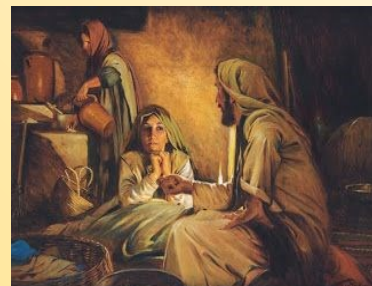

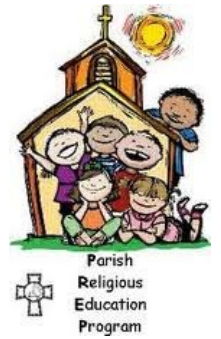

It will direct you to the Child and Youth Protection Site. If you have not completed your background checks and the class YOU MAY NOT VOLUNTEER.**
