# In Ordinary Time

# The Fifth Sunday

Dear Friends.

As we celebrate the Fifth Sunday and week of Ordinary Time, our scripture readings this week continued the theme of discipleship. We who were called to live the Beatitudes last week are now encouraged to let our light shine. Jesus proclaimed us the salt of the earth and the light of the world. How can we be all that? The prophet Isaiah in our first reading points out the way: feed the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless, clothe the naked. There is no mention of whether they are "deserving." When we do these things, then our light will "break forth like the dawn." This week we are called to, and challenged to be, the LIGHT OF THE WORLD!

The scriptures this week set the stage beautifully for the kick-off of the annual CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL. This year's theme is "GIVING HOPE TO ALL." This Appeal is the single most important annual fundraising initiative of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and we need everyone's support. This year the Appeal will be a channel of hope for tens of thousands of people through countless organizations and ministries in the archdiocese, and serve as a positive source for good in all facets of the Church in Philadelphia. The goal of this Appeal is \$12.5 million dollars with the beneficiaries grouped into five key areas of focus: Education, Social Services. Evangelization (Parish and Spiritual Life), Clergy and Local Mission Activities. Throughout the year we will be highlighting these five key constituents. Our parish goal for this year has been raised by 10% of the goal we reached for the past several years. This year's goal is \$71,901. You may use the envelope that has been mailed directly from the Appeal's office to your home or you may contribute through their website at www.catholiccharitiesappeal.org We will keep you posted on how our parish progresses towards this goal. I know your generosity will reflect your concern for the poor and needy in our area- you have always been a source of care and concern for the less fortunate. Many thanks as we embark on another year of charitable giving throughout the archdiocese.

This weekend at the 9AM Mass we will celebrate Rites for those who are preparing to become members of the Catholic Church this Easter season. At that Mass we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of the Catechumen for BUNNY SCHOENECK. Bunny is preparing to enter the Church at the Easter Vigil through Baptism. We will also celebrate the Rite of Welcoming Baptized Adults Preparing for Full Communion with the Catholic Church for MICHAEL RONN. Mike will be received into the Church, along with DEVON KOHLER (who participated in the Rite of Welcome in the fall), at a Sunday Mass celebrated during the Easter Season. Please keep Bunny, Mike and Devon in your prayers as they near their entrance into the Church and our community at Eastertime.

May Saint Robert Bellarmine inspire us to a new appreciation for our faith and a renewed spirit of giving hope to others!



# **OPTIONS FOR PREP CLASSES FOR FALL 2017 NEW AND RETURNING FAMILIES**

Starting in September of 2017, we will offer 2 options for PREP classes.

1st Option — Traditional PREP Classes.... Your child would attend class each Monday afternoon from 5:00 to 6:15 PM from September to May. Included in this program is attendance at one family gathering and one spiritual gathering. Registration will take place in May.

2nd Option— Family Program.... Your child and at least one parent would attend a Family session once a month from October to May. Your family would attend the 9:00 AM Mass and then come over to school for the session. The children will go to grade appropriate classes while the parents will learn about the same subject the children are in their class. Since there are 3 chapters in each unit, you would complete the remaining chapters with your child. Online support is also available.
