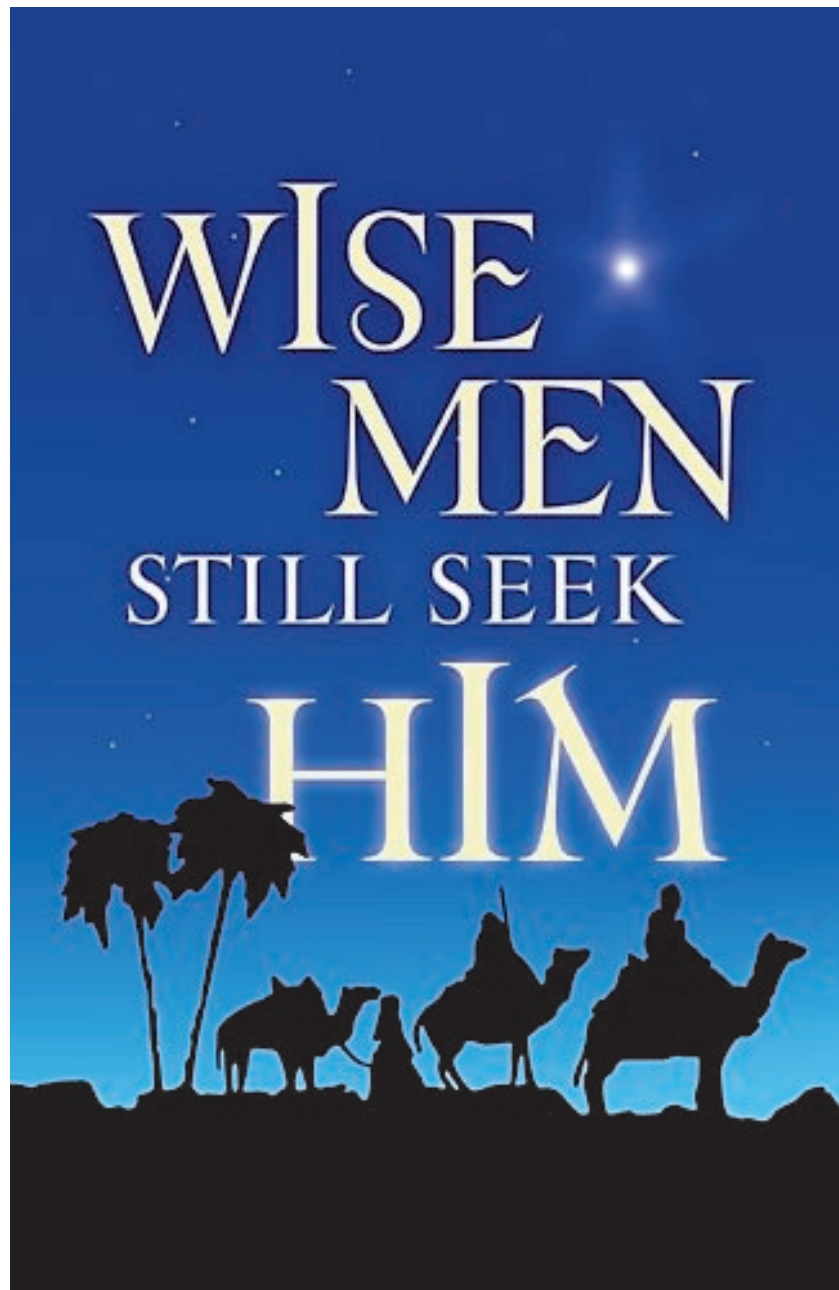

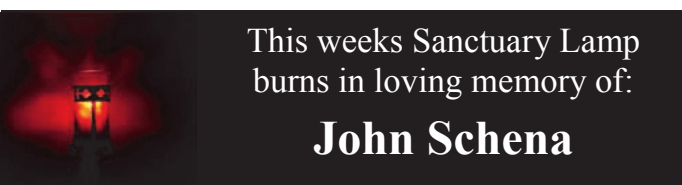

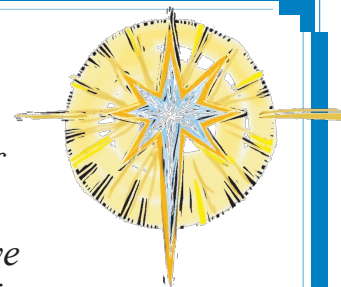

Dear Friends,

The Christmas season continues today with our celebration of the Epiphany. Matthew's Gospel makes it clear that even from the very beginning Jesus came to save all people of the world. And so we have magi, representing all the known world at the time, making their way to Jesus' humble birthplace. Gathered as we are from many places, let us pray in thanksgiving that God has seen fit to reach out to all of us in love.

This week we will return to our regular daily Mass schedule with Masses being celebrated in church at 7AM and 9 AM. As a new year's resolution, perhaps attending a Mass during the week for the intention of world peace or family harmony might be a good practice to adopt. It's just a thought!

I want to publicly thank the Louis Swift Plunkett Funeral Home for once again providing the parish with an annual calendar. It is another form of evangelization to hang this calendar, with its beautiful religious art work, in your home or workplace.

This is the first opportunity I have had, by way of the bulletin, to announce the good news that Archbishop Chaput has approved, with the unanimous vote of the College of Consultors, the renovation and expansion project for our parish. This concludes the required process established within the guidelines of the archdiocese for a major capital project. We now are in the process of applying for the necessary permits from Warrington Township to begin the demolition of the Cranney Learning Center to make way for the new parish office center. Please keep this project in your prayers and consider supporting it with your sacrificial gift. Remember, EVERYONE will benefit from this project!

Next Sunday, January 11th, we will have COFFEE IN CRANNEY after all the Masses. I have been made aware, and I have always suspected, that many people have never been in the Cranney Learning Center once the new church was built and the former sanctuary closed. This will give everyone the opportunity to see this space prior to its demolition and reconstruction. Please plan to stop back there next Sunday to share some coffee and donuts with your friends and fellow parishioners before this area of the campus is closed.

May this new year hold for you and your family the blessings of peace, love and joy that this world cannot give!

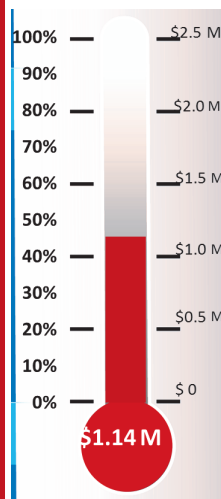

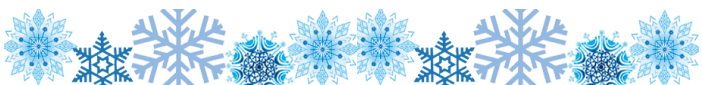

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Isaiah 60:1-6; Ephesians 3:2-3a,5-6; Matthew 2:1-12

Epiphany marks the moment when the news of Jesus as king begins to be revealed to the world. The magi, who were most likely ancient Persian priests, are called by mysterious forces to visit and honor a newborn child. This is significant because the magi were from a culture that would typically not have accepted the God of Israel. We tend to live by common sense and logic and who of us would ever follow a star into the unknown? Yet, these men brought gifts as a way to pay homage to Jesus.

On this day, let us remember that in spite of some of our own choices, God shines divine glory upon us and calls us to “walk by the light.” Is there a change you can make this new year to help you “walk by the light?”
