

The Sixteenth Sunday

The Gospel for the Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time picks up immediately after last Sunday's. The apostles, fresh from their missionary travels, return to Jesus and report on what they have done. Jesus invited them to come and rest. But of course, rest was impossible, and the crowds surrounded Jesus, who felt pity for them. Many in the world today do not feel the need to surround themselves with Jesus. There is a growing indifference to His presence in the world and the need to rely upon his life and grace for direction and sustenance. Let us pray that we always feel the need for Jesus, always wanting to be near to Him and comforted by his life and grace. In this we will be like sheep who have a shepherd to lead and guide us!

This weekend our youth group is attending conferences in Steubenville Ohio. They will be returning to us on Sunday evening. Please remember to pray for their safe return and that the weekend was for them a time of commitment to a deeper relationship with their loving Lord.

Demolition has begun in the former Cranney Learning Center. This is the first phase of the construction of the new parish office center. You will be seeing more and more materials and equipment on the property as the summer unfolds. We will eventually be closing church access through Monsignor Marley Hall because of the project. There will be additional spaces in the front of church and the sidewalk behind church for any cars marked with the physically disabled license plate or placard. We will do our best to see that the walk to church is close and unimpeded for our parishioners with special needs. This past Thursday we met with the construction company and architect to formulate a construction calendar. I will be sharing some of that with in future bulletins. Again, be prepared for some inconvenience and I thank you in advance for your patience as we expand and construct our facilities.

I am grateful for your consistent sacrificial giving over the summer months. Unfortunately, bills do not take a vacation, as all of you know! I appreciate all those who have been "making up" for their vacation Sundays away from our parish. It greatly assists us in meeting the ongoing financial obligations of the parish.

Speaking of money, this past Friday, the parish contracted with First Niagara for the construction loan needed to complete the parish project. After construction is completed this loan will become a mortgage for the parish. Although we have been approved for a \$2.0M loan, we will not need to borrow that much. My goal is to borrow no more than \$1.0M. However this will depend on the final level of pledges and gifts from you! If you have yet to commit to the parish campaign, there is still time. If you need a pledge card or information, please visit our website or retrieve information from the entrances to church. We thankfully accept all gifts – large or small. Thank you in advance.

FOCUS ON FAITH

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Jeremiah 23:1-6; Ephesians 2:13-18; Mark 6:30-34

As Jesus directs in today's Gospel, we all need to go off to a "deserted place" occasionally to "rest a while." We can do this, for example, when we ...

- taking some time each day to pray and rest in God
- making Sunday truly a day of rest
- rest with family and friends over a leisurely meal or having time away together
- or maybe setting aside a few days each year to make a retreat.

We all need time to regain our strength so that we can take up our own "shepherding tasks." These includes sharing the Good News with others with joyful words and deeds and by forgiving others and restoring relationships.



MARRIAGE



In light of the recent Supreme Court decision this is a good time to be reminded about what the Church teaches about the <u>Sacrament of Marriage</u>. In November 2009 the U.S. Catholic Bishops approved a pastoral letter called "**Marriage: Love and Life in the Divine Plan.**" The letter presents the essential points of Catholic teaching on marriage as a *natural gift, as a sacrament, and as a public commitment between a man and a woman*. It also discusses several contemporary challenges to marriage and how the Church addresses those challenges.

A few quotes from the document:

Marriage: A Natural and Spiritual Blessing: "While marriage is a special blessing for Christians because of the grace of Christ, marriage is also a natural blessing and gift for everyone in all times and cultures. It is a source of blessing to the couple, to their families, and to society and includes the wonderous gift of co-creating human life."

What is Marriage? "Marriage is a lifelong partnership of the whole of life, of mutual and exclusive fidelity, established by mutual consent between a man and a woman, and ordered towards the good of the spouses and the procreation of offspring."

Marriage: Children: "Marriage is not merely a private institution. It is the foundation for the family, where children learn the values and virtues that will make good Christians because of the grace of Christ, marriage is also a natural blessing and gift for everyone in all times and cultures. It is a source of blessing to the couple, to their families, and to society and includes the wonderous gift of co-creating human life."

Parents-first evangelizers: "Not only do parents present their children for Baptism, but, having done so, they become the first evangelizers and teachers of the faith. They evangelize by teaching their children to pray and by praying with them. They bring their children to Mass and teach them biblical stories. They show them how to obey God's commandments and to live a Christian life of holiness.

Here are some of the other topics covered in the document: Marriage and the Eucharist, Growing Together in the Virtues, Natural Family Planning, Domestic Violence, Annulments, Effects of Cohabitation, Relativism, Contraception, Reproductive Technology and much more.

Share your faith this summer—talk to your neighbors, invite a lapsed Catholic back to the Church! Pope Francis reminds us over and over again that we are called to walk with one other on our journey of faith and encourage each other for it is a sacred journey:

"The Church (us) will have to initiate everyone—priests, religious and laity—into this art of accompaniment, which teaches us to remove our sandals before the sacred ground of the other ." Gospel of Joy, 169
