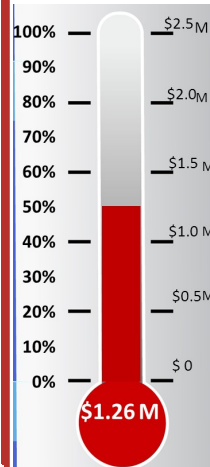

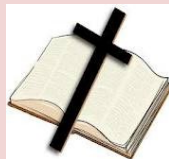

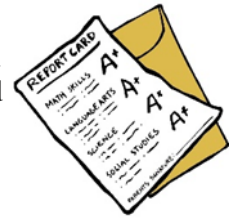

FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

2 Chronicles 36:14-16; 19-23; Ephesians 2:4-10; John 3:14-21



In teaching Nicodemus, Jesus uses a familiar story from the Old Testament (Numbers 21:4-9) about Moses. When Moses lifted up a bronze snake in the desert for all to see, those who had been bitten by snakes were healed. Jesus says that he too must be lifted up so that all might have eternal life through him. He will be lifted up on the cross. But he will also be lifted up in his resurrection and in his ascension to the Father. Whoever looks at him in faith will receive eternal life. Followers of Jesus recognize him as the Light that came into the world. They live truthfully in the Light, unlike those who choose the darkness and/or do evil deeds.

Love is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive

Presenter: Kevin L. Hughes, Ph.D., Chair of the Humanities Department, Villanova University; Husband and Father of three.

Hello everyone. My name is Brian Dulin and I am a junior at La Salle College High School, and this letter will explain to you about what I will be doing this summer, and to ask you for

your support. This summer, myself and two hundred fifty other La Salle students will be traveling throughout the United States and the Caribbean to perform a week of service to the less fortunate. Groups will be traveling to the Appalachian region of West Virginia; to the Blackfeet Reservation in Montana; The Gulf Coast; St. Lucia; Puerto Rico, The Navajo Nation in Arizona; New York City, France, as well as right here in Philadelphia. Personally, I will be traveling to and working in Montana in the Blackfeet reservation, and look forward to doing the good works we are all called to perform in the name of Catholic Social Justice. While these trips are clearly designed as work trips, they are spiritual as well. We will participate in daily morning prayer, evening reflection, the keeping of journals, as well as our being immersed into the communities and cultures we will serve in order to better understand and experience the true challenges of poverty, as well as to encounter firsthand Christ, in the people we serve.

Needless to say this is an opportunity of a lifetime, but one which also requires a significant financial commitment, which is why I am here today. I have personally contributed to the cost of my trip, as well as participated in a letter writing campaign in order to offset the direct cost of my trip. However, getting to these locations is only half of the challenge. Additional funds are needed to buy the supplies necessary to keep all of us productive during our time, and to maximize the true impact we can have on these destitute communities.

I would like to request two things from you. First your prayerful support of our efforts, and secondly your financial support. While I know that these are not easy times for many of us, I also know the St. Roberts community and our collective focus on Catholic Social Justice. If you can support myself and the other La Salle students in any way, I will be in the back of church after Mass the weekend of **March 22nd** to answer any questions you might have, and to accept whatever financial support you might be able to provide. I thank you for your time, and again ask for your continued prayers as we seek to make a difference and build community. Thank you.
