
REPORT CARDS:

Hello everyone. My name is Brian Dulin and I am a junior at La Salle College High School, and this letter will explain to you about what I will be doing this summer, and to ask you for

your support. This summer, myself and two hundred fifty other La Salle students will be traveling throughout the United States and the Caribbean to perform a week of service to the less fortunate. Groups will be traveling to the Appalachian region of West Virginia; to the Blackfeet Reservation in Montana; The Gulf Coast; St. Lucia; Puerto Rico, The Navajo Nation in Arizona; New York City, France, as well as right here in Philadelphia. Personally, I will be traveling to and working in Montana in the Blackfeet reservation, and look forward to doing the good works we are all called to perform in the name of Catholic Social Justice.
