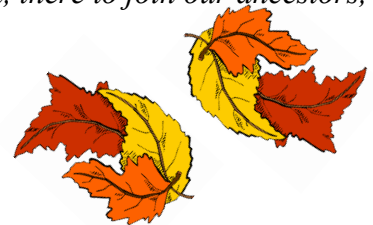
This week our Church celebrates the reality of our faith in the Saints and the Souls of our Faithful Departed. This Tuesday we will celebrate the Holy Day of Obligation with the Solemnity of All Saints. Masses will be celebrated on Tuesday at 7AM, 9AM, 12 Noon and 7PM. On Wednesday we will celebrate the Commemoration of All Souls. Masses on Wednesday will be celebrated at 7AM, 9AM and 7PM. At the evening Mass we will remember in a special way all those parishioners who died this year and for whom we celebrated the Mass of Christian Burial in our church. Following this Mass we will host a reception in the narthex. All parishioners are invited to participate in this celebration of our faithful departed. May they rest in peace! In addition to this special celebration, we will be praying daily for those members of our families and friends whose names have been submitted through the All Souls envelopes. These will be placed in the sanctuary near the Holy Family shrine as a daily reminder of the need to pray for the dead and to honor their legacy.

In preparation for the upcoming elections, you will find a voters' guide in this bulletin entitled "Know the Positions of the Presidential Candidates." The guide was prepared by the Pennsylvania Catholic Conference of Bishops to assist us with voting. Please study the positions of the candidates and vote accordingly. I have received several copies of a wonderful and powerful YouTube video concerning the upcoming election. If you go to YouTube and type in the Diocese of Phoenix, homily October 2, 2016, you will hear the most articulate and challenging homily I have ever heard concerning the election in light of the scourge of abortion. It is brilliantly crafted and powerfully delivered. Another resource for voting preparation is the writings of our own archbishop which can be found in CatholicPhilly.com Let us continue to pray for one another as we accept the responsibility and challenge to elect our next president on November 8th.
