This recognition just doesn't happen. It takes the leadership and commitment of every member of the school community, beginning with the administration and faculty, staff and students, parents and parish. Our school is a little gem, tucked away in the secure and idyllic setting of our campus. Open House is today (Sunday). This past week I received a report from the Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia notifying me of our parish's contribution to the annual Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary collection conducted last November. This is a wonderful opportunity for our brother priests to walk in the footsteps of Jesus and allow the scriptures to come alive through this experience.
