

# The Presentation

Of the Lord

Dear Friends.

Today we suspend the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time and rather gather to celebrate the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after Jesus was born, in accordance with the Torah (the Jewish Scriptures), Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem to be presented to the Lord. What they could not have known is that two elderly daily worshippers in the temple, Anna and Simeon, would recognize in the six-week-old child the Savior of the world. In light of this special feast today, let us challenge ourselves to recognize Jesus in the faces of those we meet this week.

Tomorrow (Monday) we celebrate the memorial of Saint Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. In keeping with the long standing devotion, we will have the Blessing of Throats at the 7AM and 9AM Mass in the chapel on Monday.

In many parts of Europe the Christmas crèche remains in place until this day, the feast of the Presentation. I remember finding this fascinating as I toured churches in Rome at the end of January during my class reunion in 2005. The custom is to keep the crèche in place until the feast when Jesus was presented in the Temple and revealed as the promised Messiah, who is the Light of the World! Even though our Christmas crèche was removed from the church in mid-January, it has not been forgotten. I am deeply grateful to one of our parishioners, FLOSS HAUSCHILD, who has been spending hours in the parish office center loft refurbishing our Nativity figures. When you see the crèche next Christmas you will see renewed figures thanks to Floss. It is hard for me to believe that we purchased the additional statues for the crèche in 2006 through the generosity of donors. Another reminder of how fleeting time really is!

I am currently in the process of completing the annual Parish Pastoral Report to the archbishop. This is a required report each year which assists the central offices of the archdiocese with data to be used in planning the future of the archdiocese and its parishes. In this report I will be reporting that we have currently 2,285 families with 7,308 members. This has been a slight growth over the past year. As you can see from the area, many homes go up for sale but are sold very quickly. Many families with young children seem to be moving in and registering with our community. We are also receiving families who are not in our geographical boundary but wish to join our parish. Often they state that they find our community welcoming and vibrant. That is a great compliment to you and your faith. Keep up the good work, it is evangelizing in every day living! I will be sharing more statistics as the report unfolds.

May this new month of February bring us closer to Jesus, who is indeed the Light of the World! Saint Robert Bellarmine, pray for us!



### EVER WONDERED HOW TO USE THE RICE BOWL?

As Lent 2020 quickly approaches and we begin to look for ways to increase our prayer, almsgiving and sacrifice throughout our Lenten journey, one suggestion is a wholehearted participation in Catholic Relief Services (CRS) Rice Bowl this year.

For those of us who may have forgotten or do not know the story of CRS Rice Bowl, it began in 1975 in a parish in the Allentown Diocese. It was a response to a call from Catholic Relief Services to help people in Africa who were starving due to a severe famine. Since that time it has grown into a national response to global hunger. Catholic Relief Services is the official relief and development agency of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Through Rice Bowl faith communities in every diocese throughout the United States put their faith into action through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Lenten alms donated through the Rice Bowl this year will be sent to over 100 countries where CRS works. Three countries will be highlighted in this year's effort: Honduras, Vietnam and Kenya. Additionally, 25% of all donations stay within the United States to offer help locally. In our Archdiocese, the 25% is shared with Nutritional Development Services which supports a network of 50 food cupboards and soup kitchens. If each family takes just one Rice Bowl, it will find a pamphlet inside the Rice Bowl with suggestions as to ways in which the family may participate. This is the beauty of this program: it enables the entire family to enter fully into the spirit of Lent. There is a calendar of suggestions, recipes from the featured countries, online stories about family life in these countries and a Lenten prayer that can be used on the night of Rice Bowl in the family's home.

Even if the recipes are not used, families can still participate by selecting one night a week on which the family will sit down to a simple, inexpensive meal. The money that would have been spent on the regular family meal gets put into the Rice Bowl. At the end of Lent the money the family donated in the Rice Bowl becomes a check which is placed into the collection basket on a specified Sunday.

This year during Lent, we are challenging families to pay attention to Global Solidarity Week which occurs the week of March 22-27. Listen and look for ways you and your family may enter more fully into solidarity with our food deprived brothers and sisters around the world. Thank you!


