The Seventh Sunday

Dear Friends,

As we celebrate the Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time we heard in the first line of the first reading from the Book of Leviticus God telling Moses, "Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy." Then in the last line of the Gospel of Matthew we heard Jesus tell his disciples, "Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." How is that for a challenge? Not only are we told to be holy, we are told to be perfect! With this call to perfection Jesus challenges us to turn the other cheek and love our enemies. These are not our instincts. It is not easy! We get angry, we are upset, we want to do or say something to express our pain and rage. This week, as we begin the season of Lent, let the example of our Lord inspire us to respond to hurt and conflict with mercy and forgiveness.

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of this penitential season known as Lent. We will be offering Mass that day at 7AM, 9AM, and 7PM. After the homily, the blessing and distribution of ashes will take place at these Masses. We will also offer a Prayer Service with the distribution of ashes at 4PM. Ashes will not be distributed outside these liturgical events. We will be visiting the nursing homes in our parish in the course of the day on Ash Wednesday. I am grateful to those who are assisting us with nursing home visits.

Ash Wednesday is also a day of FAST AND ABSTINENCE. Catholics 14 years of age and older are to refrain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays of Lent. Catholics 18 years of age until their 59th birthday are also to FAST on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. That means that you are permitted one full meal that day with two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Beginning Ash Wednesday and continuing throughout Lent, except for Sundays, we will gather each day in chapel at 8:45 AM for the recitation of MORNING PRAYER, the universal prayer of the Church. This prayer joins us with our brothers and sisters throughout the world praying a common prayer for the sanctification of the world and our own spiritual well-being. Prayer books will be provided and you will be guided through the prayer each morning.

Stations of the Cross will begin this Friday and continue for the Fridays of Lent. Stations will begin at 7PM in church followed by Exposition, Scripture Reading, Homily and Benediction. Please consider this wonderful Lenten practice for you and your family.

Lent is the time for additional spiritual practices and disciplines. Please take a Lenten booklet and spend at least five minutes with the Lord each day. Perhaps you can attend daily Mass each day or even one day during the week. You can also read the daily Mass readings which you can easily get online. Church is open during the day for a Holy Hour or a brief visit before the Blessed Sacrament (we have weekly Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Mondays after the 9AM Mass until 4PM). Perhaps you can pick up a book from our parish library in the narthex and do some spiritual reading during these days of Lent. A daily rosary could provide that spiritual encounter you need, especially the Sorrowful Mysteries, even saying the rosary in the car to and from work each day. It may calm your nerves while driving! Of course, we will have our annual Parish Mission in March as well as our Confession Night with many additional priests to help with the Sacrament of Penance. Take the front cover of this bulletin, place it in a prominent place in your homes and see it as an invitation to grow closer to the Lord this Lent!

Last weekend we held an investiture for our new altar servers. I am grateful to Luca Berg, Jason Hong and Ashley Stefanik and their families for this commitment to service for our parish community.

Today we celebrate the entrance into FULL COMMUNION in THE CATHOLIC CHURCH for Kurt Schollin and Gary Johnson. We are so grateful to the Holy Spirit who has led these men to become one with us in faith and practice. Congratulations Gary and Kurt and welcome!

May Saint Robert Bellarmine bless our Lenten journey and inspire us to spiritual growth during this sacred time.


Not available at those times? The Masses are recorded! Just look back at for the post.
