The First Sunday



Of Lent

Every year on the first Sunday of Lent, the focus is on temptation. Adam and Eve are tempted by the serpent in the garden of Eden. Jesus is tempted in the desert by the devil. Though the temptations in our life may not be as dramatic as those in Genesis or the Gospels, they may be just as powerful. As we begin this first week of Lent, let us pray daily during these days for the strength to resist temptation and for mercy when we fail.

Please consult the front page of the bulletin for all of the opportunities of grace during this sacred, penitential season. See this page as an invitation to participate and to invite others to these encounters with the Lord.

Last weekend we received into Full Communion in the Catholic Church two parishioners, Kurt Schollin and Gary Johnson. It was a beautiful, moving event for those who were present. At that time I invited the congregation to look around to see if they know anyone who may be inclined to consider joining our faith. If so, I challenged them to courageously invite the person to explore or pray about the invitation. This inviting is the work of evangelization in which everyone is called to participate. There is no pressure to join, just an honest conversation may begin the process.

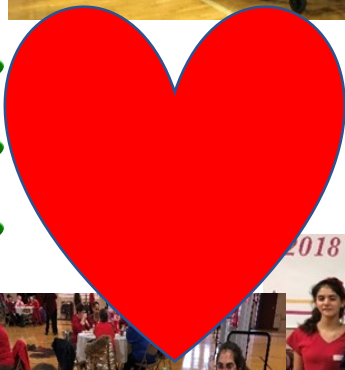

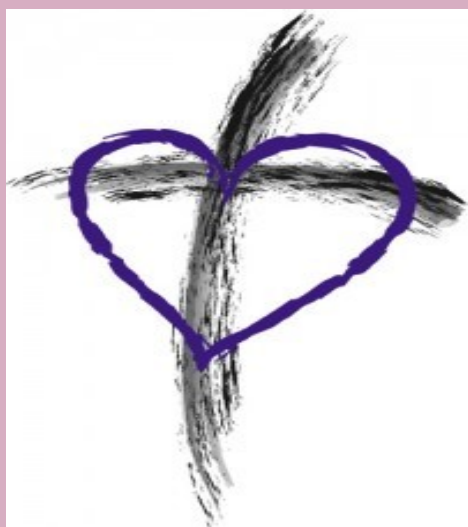
