

Saint Report Guidelines

The name chosen must be a Blessed or canonized Christian saint. A canonized Christian Saint is a man or a woman who has displayed heroic virtue and has been recognized by the Church. During Confirmation preparation time, candidates should research Saint's name they have chosen. After you have selected the Saint you would like to be named after (and who will continue to pray for you), you will do research about the saint.

This year, we are going to place a display of your saint project in the narthex of the church. Find a picture of your saint and place it in either a 5x7 or 8x10 standing picture frame. Dollar Tree has a great selection of frames.

The saint I chose to pray to and imitate in my preparation for Confirmation is: (be sure to use the saint's COMPLETE name.....ie. St. Francis of Assisi, there may be many saints with the same first name, so specify!) **The saint's name should be on the front with the picture.**

On the back of the frame include the following and glue/tape it to the back of the frame. **BE SURE YOUR NAME IS ON THE PROJECT.**

1. Why did you choose this saint?
2. How could you imitate this saint today? Be specific!
- 3 . When was this saint canonized or beatified by the Catholic Church? Does your saint have a feast day? If so, what is the date?
4. If your saint is a patron saint, what of?
